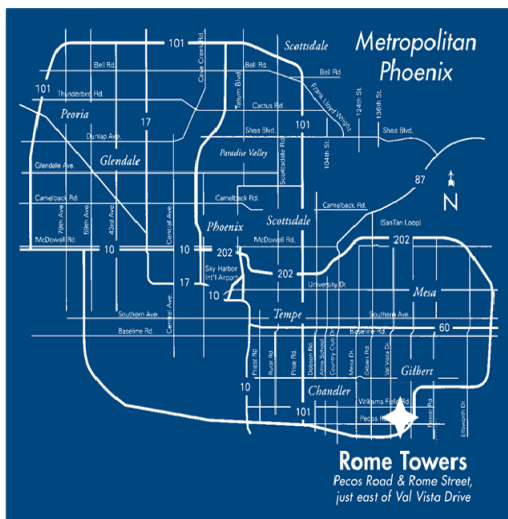


Leaps and Bounds

What is Habilitation and Respite?

Habilitation Services: Habilitation is a service available to individuals with developmental disabilities. These services include a range of assistance or training to enable clients to perform routine tasks necessary for essential life functioning. These services are provided in the client’s home, in the community, or at our Center to assist individuals in acquiring, retaining, and improving self-help, socialization, and adaptive skills.

Respite Care: Respite refers to short term or temporary care of individuals with disabilities in order for their parent(s) or guardian to take a break from the day to day stress of caregiving.

Who would most likely be great Habilitation and Respite caregivers?

- Those who are good with kids.
- People who are patient.
- Someone looking for a rewarding job.
- Those looking for a flexible non-traditional work-week.
- Someone looking for a job that doesn’t require a degree or lots of experience but pays well.

What do I need to get started?

Qualifications

- Fingerprint Clearance and Criminal Record Self-Disclosure
- First Aid and CPR/AED Certification (one day training)
- Article 9 training - A self-study course
- Habilitation services training (3 months under the direct supervision of a qualified habilitation provider)
- Intervention training (recommended)

Leaps and Bounds will assist you through the process of getting started. We will also reimburse for training costs if you agree to sign on and work with us.
